



BUSINESS CONTINUITY & DISASTER RECOVERY ADDENDUM TO IGEL END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT (EULA)

THIS ADDENDUM SETS FORTH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS THAT ARE SPECIFIC TO THE BUSINESS CONTINUITY & DISASTER RECOVERY LICENSE VERSIONS OF THE IGEL SOFTWARE ("IGEL BC&DR SOFTWARE"). THIS ADDENDUM IS IN ADDITION TO THE STANDARD TERMS IN THE APPLICABLE IGEL END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT ("EULA") BY AND BETWEEN IGEL AND END USER. IN THE EVENT OF ANY CONFLICT BETWEEN THE TERMS OF THE EULA AND THIS ADDENDUM, THE RELEVANT TERMS OF THIS ADDENDUM SHALL PREVAIL SOLELY AS TO END USER'S ACCESS AND USE OF IGEL BC&DR SOFTWARE. PLEASE READ THIS ADDENDUM CAREFULLY BEFORE USING IGEL BC&DR SOFTWARE. BY CLICKING "ACCEPT" (OR OTHERWISE ASSENTING TO THE TERMS OF THIS ADDENDUM) OR ACCESSING, INSTALLING, OR OTHERWISE USING THE IGEL BC&DR SOFTWARE, YOU (A) ACCEPT THIS ADDENDUM AND AGREE THAT END USER IS BOUND BY ITS TERMS; AND (B) REPRESENT AND WARRANT THAT YOU HAVE THE RIGHT, POWER, AND AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO THIS ADDENDUM ON BEHALF OF END USER AND BIND END USER TO ITS TERMS. IF END USER DOES NOT AGREE TO THE TERMS OF THIS ADDENDUM, IGEL DOES NOT LICENSE THE IGEL BC&DR SOFTWARE TO END USER, AND END USER SHALL NOT ACCESS, INSTALL OR USE THE IGEL BC&DR SOFTWARE, AND END USER SHALL PROMPTLY RETURN THE UNUSED IGEL BC&DR SOFTWARE TO THE RESELLER FROM WHOM IT WAS OBTAINED.

- 1. IGEL Business Continuity & Disaster Recovery Software License.** Subject to and conditioned upon End User's compliance with the restrictions and other terms and conditions of the EULA and this Addendum and full payment of the applicable Subscription Key fees, IGEL hereby grants to End User a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable and non-sublicensable license to use the IGEL BC&DR Software for which End User has purchased a Subscription Key for End User's internal business purposes in testing for or during a Business Continuity and/or Disaster Recovery Event and solely in accordance with the Documentation ("IGEL BC&DR Software License"). Use of the IGEL BC&DR Software under the IGEL BC&DR Software License shall be strictly limited to the number and type of licenses as set forth on the applicable Order Form and for a maximum of forty-five (45) days per calendar year. A Business Continuity and/or Disaster Recovery Event is any unplanned, unforeseeable, or extraordinary circumstance or occurrence, whether natural or man-made, that materially disrupts, prevents or substantially impairs a party's ability to access, operate or utilize the applicable systems or infrastructure in the ordinary course of business.
- 2. IGEL USB Boot.** If End User desires to utilize the IGEL BC&DR Software License on an IGEL UDPocket USB boot drive, End User must separately purchase both: (1) a UDPocket Subscription License and (2) the IGEL BC&DR Software License. Purchasing these two licenses will grant End User the right to receive and use a standard IGEL BC&DR Software image on a dedicated IGEL UDPocket USB drive, allowing the End User to run the IGEL BC&DR Software on a Device directly from the USB drive ("USB Boot License"). Each USB Boot License only permits a single Device to use the USB Boot mode. During the applicable term, IGEL will address any defective UDPocket drives pursuant to the RMA (Return Material Authorization) policy, the details of which are available at <http://kb.igel.com/hardware/current/igel-business-continuity-usb-boot>.
